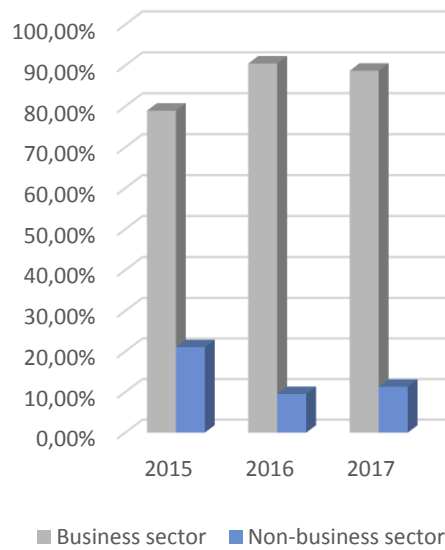

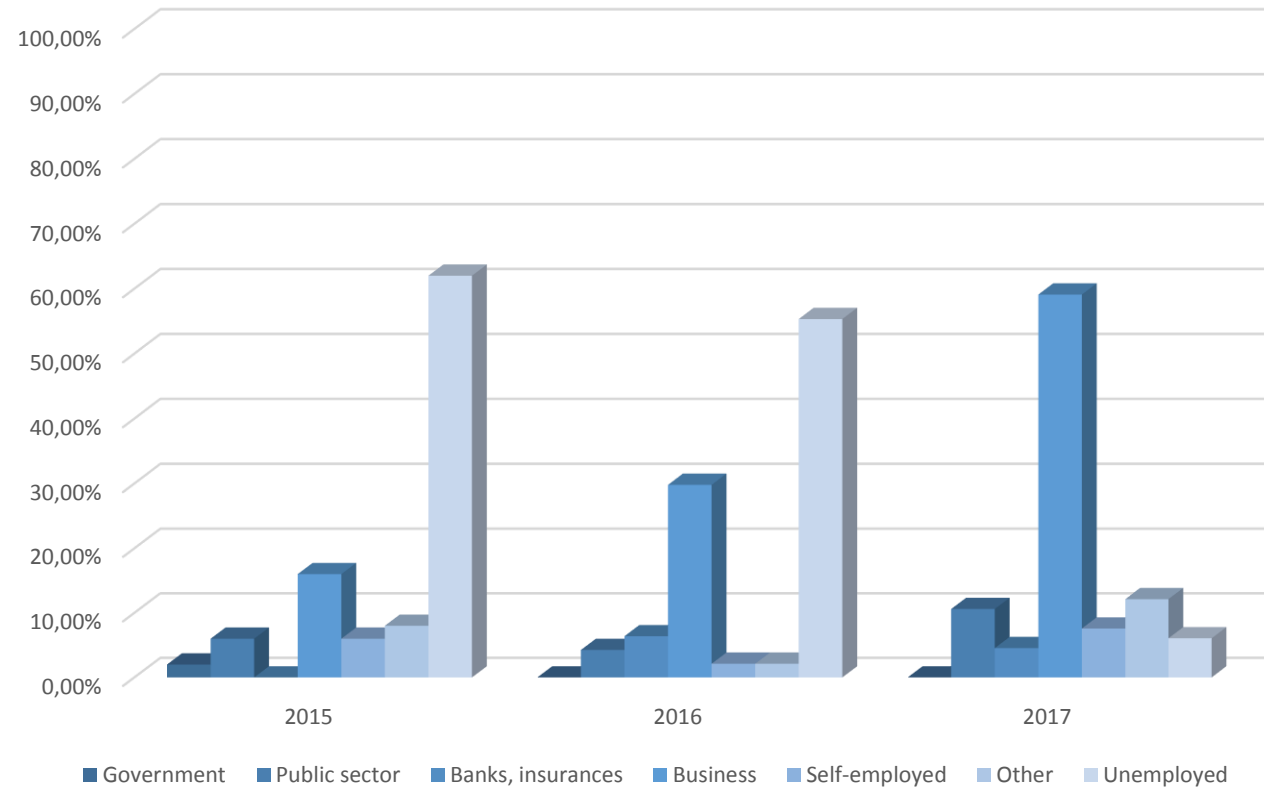

Employment ratio in business and non-business

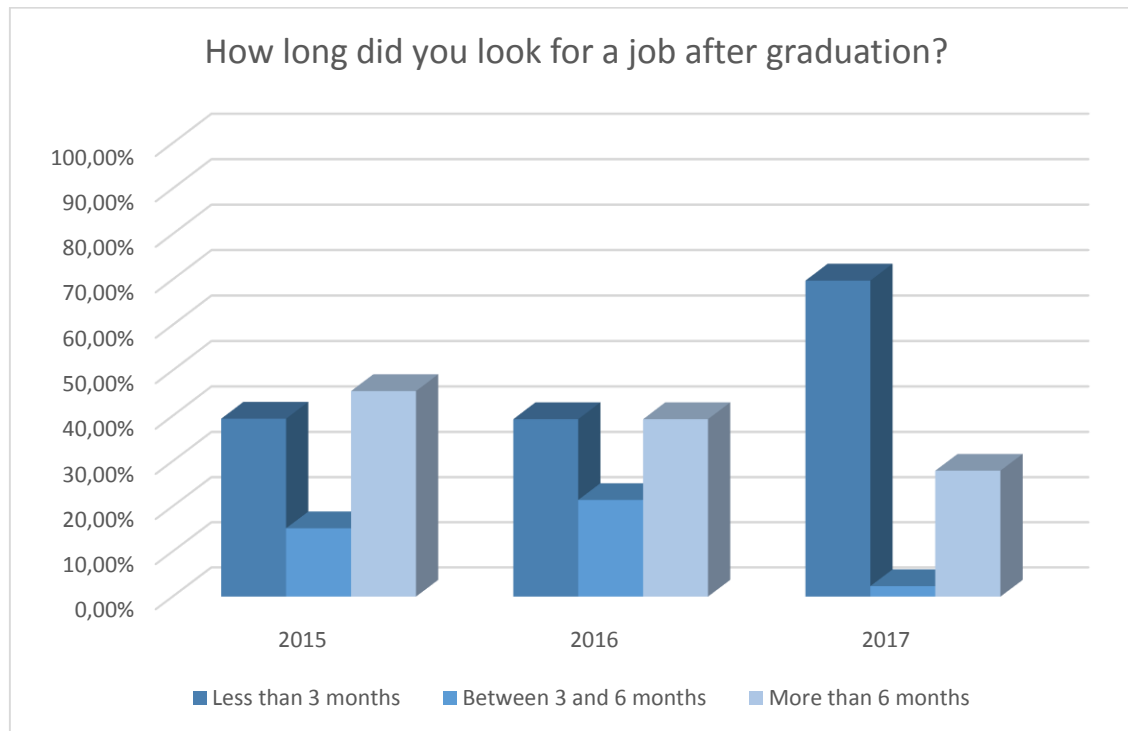
